

# CCAPP Postdoctoral Fellows in Cosmology and Astro-Particle Physics

The Ohio State University Departments of Astronomy and Physics invite applications for CCAPP Postdoctoral Fellows as part of the OSU Initiative to establish the Center for Cosmology and Astro-Particle Physics (CCAPP). A successful candidate should be able to carry out a vigorous independent research program in observational or theoretical cosmology and/or experimental or theoretical astro-particle physics interacting with CCAPP members and researchers at other institutions while utilizing extensive CCAPP resources and infrastructure (<http://ccapp.mps.ohio-state.edu>). Appointments will be for Regular (3 year) or Long-Term (5 year) Fellowships. Long-Term Fellows are expected to play a significant role in the overall scientific direction of the CCAPP, and will be paid above postdoctoral level.

Applications should include a curriculum vita, a bibliography of publications, and a brief description of proposed research. The applicant should request 3 letters of reference to be sent as well.
