

# Electrical Safety Program

**- How it works to protect you -  
Safety by Design**

## **NRTL/EEIP**

Ensures equipment meets minimum safety standards

## **ESC Review**

Ensures projects meet minimum safety standards

## **Common Example**

**Polarized Lamp Plug**



Polarized plug ensures hot lead is connected to the recessed center connection of the lamp

## **Safety by Work Practices**

## **NFPA 70E/ESH Ch. 8**

Establishes appropriate work practices for working on or near exposed electrical equipment

## **Training**

Provides workers with the information needed to apply safety work practices

## **PPE**

An acknowledgement of a hazard, but provides a minimum level of protection

## **Common Example**

Unplugging the lamp before changing the bulb to prevent accidental exposure of energized parts
